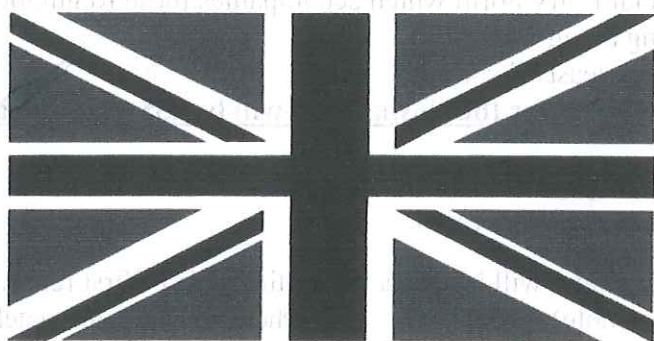

ENTRIES: Must be made on the official Entry Form which accompanies these Regulations and sent to the Secretary of the Meeting along with

- Two Stamped addressed envelopes at least 9" x 4".
- Correct Entries fee of **£25.00**. **Entries After the closing date will be £35.00 and Name may not be in the Programme.**

- Cheques and Money Orders should be payable to **Western Classic M.C.C.**

Entries will not be confirmed until cheques have cleared.

Entries may have to be limited in number and will be allocated on the basis of first received subject to the Organisers discretion (see note) Entries will close when the limits are reached or on the **16th July 2016**

MACHINE ELIGIBILITY: The machines eligible for the Event must conform to the current rules. In general all machines must utilise engine, frame, forks, gearbox and hubs of British Manufacture and be fitted with an efficient silencer. Only approved Trials Tyres may be fitted.

COURSE: The course will be laid out entirely on private land and will comprise of 4 Miles a lap, 15 Sections to be completed 2 times. All sections will be laid out in the style of a trial in the 1960's. Wherever possible sidecars will use the same sections as solos with deviations in White

START: The first man will start at 11.00 a.m. **All competitors must be signed on by 10.30 am.** In order to minimise queuing riders will be despatched in groups to various sections. There is free camping at the site and it will be open from 6.00 p.m. on Friday 29th July

GENERAL: All machines will be inspected for eligibility. **AUTHENTIC** clothing of the style in use in the 1960's must be worn. **MODERN OVERSUITS BEARING ADVERTISING** will not be permitted. Riders are required to join in the spirit of recreating a Classic Trial for the spectators. The same as any machine found not to be in the spirit of the Trials will be classed as a special and excluded from the results.

Frames, Forks, Hubs, Engine, Gear Box and Carburettors must be of a type used before the cut off date for that particular class.

Best in Class (Minimum of 6 riders)

Second in Class (Minimum of 12 riders)

Third in Class (Minimum of 20 riders)
