

### EDINBURGH & DISTRICT MOTOR CLUB LTD PRE '65 SCOTTISH TWO DAY TRIAL SILVER JUBILEE TRIAL – 1984 to 2009

#### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING ENTRY FORM

The Edinburgh & District Motor Club Ltd will run a Two Day National Trial for Pre '65 motorcycles at Kinlochleven on Friday 1 and Saturday 2 May 2009 starting at 10 am each day. The event will be run under "No Stop" rules.

Entries will be limited to a maximum of 180 and will be accepted from riders resident in any EU country holding a requisite licence. All riders must be over 18 years of age at date of trial.

All riders must be licence holders and those resident outwith the UK will be required to produce a 'Start Permission' from their home federation (to be obtained after your entry is confirmed if you are successful in the ballot). The Organisers reserve the right to allocate a number of entries at their discretion. Should the event be over-subscribed all other entries will be selected by ballot. If you wish to be considered for an entry in the event of a re-ballot, please indicate this on your completed entry form.

Competition Licence (must be valid for Trial dates) - You MUST produce your licence at signingon. ACU Registration Card holders must include the SACU Levy of £1.50 with entry fee. Please Note: One Event Licences will no longer be issued for this event.

As part of the course is on the public highway all riders must ensure that their bike is legal to ride on the UK highway and complies with all road traffic act requirements. Any competitor stopped by the Police, reported to the Secretary's Office, cautioned or charged with a road traffic offence will be immediately excluded from the trial. Competitors, by entering the trial, authorise the Clerk of the Course to make such enquiries as may be deemed necessary. The rest of the route will be on unsurfaced roads, paths and rough country and will not exceed 25 miles each day.

**Supplementary Road Traffic Act Insurance** is available for the Third Party Cover necessary to meet the Road Traffic Act requirements on the Road Sections of the event. If you comply with the following criteria, road cover is available at a cost of £15.75 for the two days:-

- over 21 and held a full licence for at least 6 months not more than 1 fault accident in last 3 years.
- no more than maximum of 6 speeding points on licence no physical or mental disabilities.
- no other material facts.

**If able to comply** with all points above simply pay the fee when your entry is accepted and sign the form for Insurance at the signing-on for the trial – No letter of acceptance will be issued.

**If you are unable to comply** with any of the above points, complete the Declaration Form (available from the Pre '65 Trial Secretary) and forward to Locktons prior to the event to allow sufficient time for a Letter of Acceptance to be issued. A 100% loading will apply which is payable to the Pre '65 Trial Secretary prior to the event.

A Trade Entry will be accepted from any rider who is a proprietor or employee of any motorcycle or associated trade to compete for the Motorcycle Trader Trophy.

Please ensure that you fully complete the entry form and machine eligibility form attached and return to the Secretary before the closing date. INCOMPLETE OR LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ENTERED INTO THE BALLOT. ANY CHANGE OF MACHINE MUST BE NOTIFIED TO THE SECRETARY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND MUST BE IN THE SAME CC CLASS OR HIGHER. Competitors are reminded that, by completing this entry form, they are declaring that the machine they will ride is eligible for this event. The presentation of a machine which does not comply with the eligibility requirements may result in exclusion and/or the rejection of any future entry from the rider concerned. Machine examination will be carried out prior to the start.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND PAYMENT WITH ENTRY – It will be requested if successful in ballot. The entry fee will be £55.00.

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#### MACHINE ELIGIBILITY GUIDANCE

In response to the concerns of riders regarding machine eligibility, the organising Committee has agreed to issue the following guidelines:-

#### **Front Forks**

Fork Sliders and yokes to be Pre'65 design only. No Bultaco, Ossa, Yamaha, etc or BSA/Triumph "4-stud".

#### Wheels - See Machine Eligibility Form

Tubeless tyres fitted with a tube on a tubeless rim MUST BE DECLARED and maybe checked. Inner tubes must be fitted – NO 'O' RINGS to be fitted. Hubs to be Pre'65 design only. No Bultaco, Fantic, Ossa, Yamaha, etc. No twin-leading shoe brakes.

#### Engine/Gearbox

No Reed valves. No hydraulic clutch operation. No BSA/Triumph B25 type square fin barrel/head.

#### **Carburettors**

Amal Concentric Mk1 acceptable. No Mk2 Concentrics. No Japanese or Italian carburettors on British machines.

(Non British machines will be allowed non-British carburettors equivalent to Mk1 Concentrics).

#### Frame

Pre'65 design only.

Rigid class entries must be a rigid framed motorcycle with an engine of a type originally fitted in a rigid frame and fitted with 'period' type forks.

A MACHINE CHECK WILL BE MADE PRIOR TO THE START AND SPOT CHECKS WILL BE CARRIED OUT DURING THE TRIAL – ANY INFRINGEMENTS MAY RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXCLUSION.

None of the above exclusions shall apply to any component of any machine which is, or proven, Pre'65 original factory fitment to that machine.

Onus of proof of eligibility shall be the responsibility of the rider.

Front Rim					1 hour before your start time to prove that a tube is fitted by loosening the valve locknut and depressing the valve.
Rear Rim					No rubber "O"rings or "Dowty washers" allowed under valve locknut. This may be checked throughout the trial.

**Machine Classes/Machine Changes** – If, prior to the event, the rider has to change his machine it must remain within its class or move up e.g.200 cc to 200cc or a larger capacity. If a rigid machine is entered a rigid must be ridden. Any problems check with Club.

I declare that the information given with regard to the eligibility of my motorcycle complies with the requirements and the spirit of this event. I understand that my entry may be refused or that I may lose marks or be excluded from the event if I have given false information with regard to the eligibility of my machine. This decision will be at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
