Announcement: The Richmond Motor Club Ltd. will promote a 3 Day SOLO Semi Sporting Trial on July 24/25/26 2009

Jurisdiction: The trial will be run under the National Sporting Code of the A.C.U. and the rules of the Yorkshire Centre A.C.U. and the following supplementary regulations. Open to all members of clubs affiliated to the Yorkshire Centre A.C.U. There will be a modified route on some sections for O40, O50 and C/Man riders.

START: Parks field, Grinton, near Reeth on the B6270 from Richmond. The start will be SILENT. Camping is available on start field in designated area. A donation of £5 per van/caravan/tent is requested. Toilets will be available.

TIME OF START: FRIDAY 11.00am SATURDAY 9.00am. SUNDAY 9.00am

Riders start in pairs at one minute intervals. Rider number 60 will start first Saturday and rider no: 120 Sunday. There will be a time limit each day.

RIDERS WILL BE PENALISED FOR LATE STARTING ONE MARK PER MINUTE UP TO A MAXIMUM 20

AWARDS: Best performance Trophy and an award. First three in each class, Best O40 & Best O50 an award. There will also be numerous sponsored awards. **No rider to win more than one award.**

Entries: Must be on the form provided and accompanied by the correct fee of **£75.00**. The promoters reserve the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason. Entry fees will only be returned if the event is cancelled. The entry fee also includes a ticket for the B.B.Q to be held on the start field, a Reeth Three Day Shirt, lunch on Saturday and Sunday and all postage & envelopes required.

Entry limit 200 ***Places will be allocated by Ballot*******

Course : Day 1. One lap of approximately 35 miles in Swaledale with 35 sections. Day 2: One lap of approx 40 miles in Swaledale & Arkengarthdale with 40 sections. Day 3: One lap in Swaledale & Arkengarthdale with 35 sections. **Roadwork will be involved. Riders and bikes must comply with the Road Traffic Act.** It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they are adequately covered by their own insurance policies or the A.C.U. RTA scheme details of which will be available from secretary. **NO DOGS ALLOWED.**

Numbers: NUMBERS, FINAL INSTRUCTIONS AND STARTING TIMES WILL BE SENT TO RIDERS BEFORE THE EVENT. A LIST OF SUCCESSFUL RIDERS WILL BE PUBLISHED SOON AFTER THE CLOSING DATE ON THE RICHMOND MOTOR CLUB WEB SITE: www.richmondmotorclub.com UNSUCCESSFUL RIDERS WILL BE NOTIFIED.

Marking: Marks will be lost on 0,1,2,3,5 basis as per Centre rules. Ties will be resolved by most cleans, most ones, twos, threes, etc. **THIS WILL BE A NO STOP TRIAL**

Machines: Solo machines only. These shall be equipped to the standard laid down in the A.C.U. schedules, including that of noise. Bikes & riders must be road legal. Police are active in this area.

Interpretation of the Regulations: These rest with the Stewards of the meeting.

Protests: As per the National Sporting Code.
