



## Creating A Clickable Link

So you've got a link you want to share with the world? Most people will not bother with a link if they have to copy and paste it into their browser's address bar. If they can just click on the link then far more people are likely to visit it.

The SIDC Forum software will automatically convert full links into clickable links.

Example:

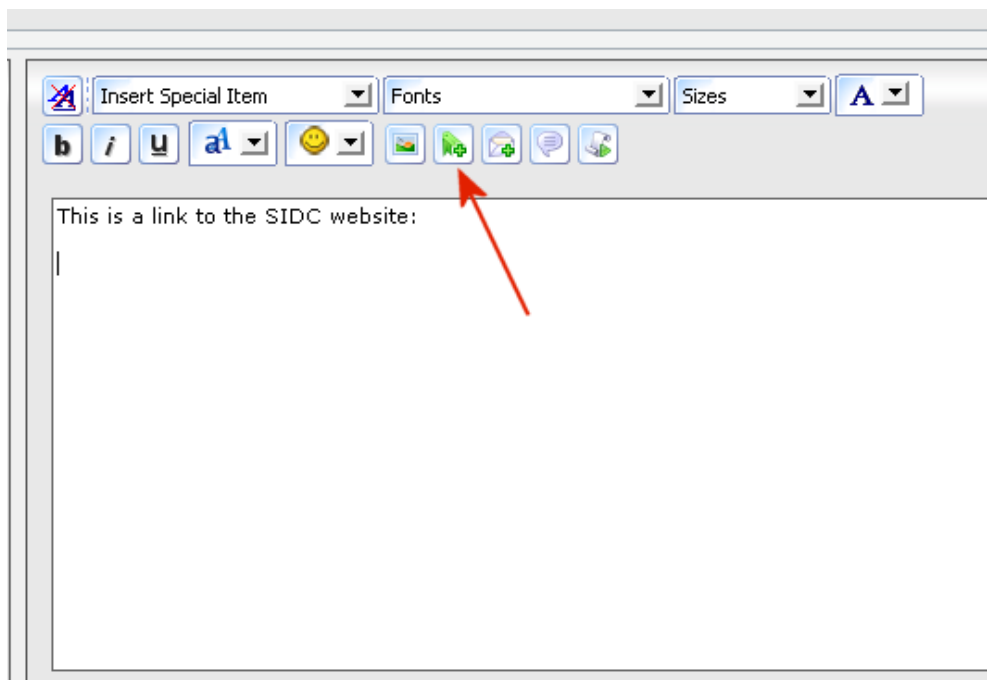
**http://www.sidc.co.uk** will automatically become <http://www.sidc.co.uk> and a link people can click on

HOWEVER

**www.sidc.co.uk** will not become a clickable link. The Forum software needs the **http://** at the start to know it is a link it is dealing with.

However you can be more fancy in the way you present your links if you wish.

When typing a new message or reply in the Forums, click on the Insert Link button as indicated by the red arrow:

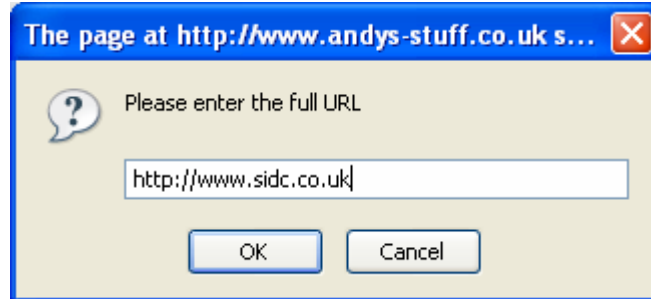

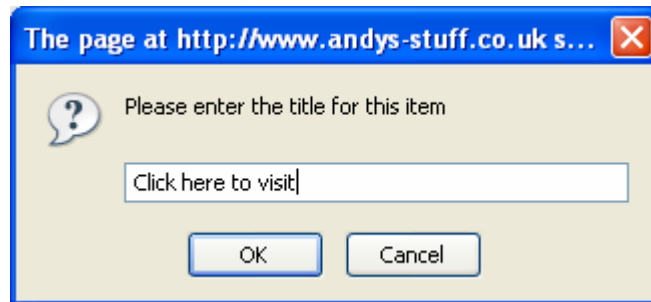


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This will present you with the following Dialog box into which you must type or paste your link:



Once you've done that, clicking on OK will ask you for the title you want for your link:

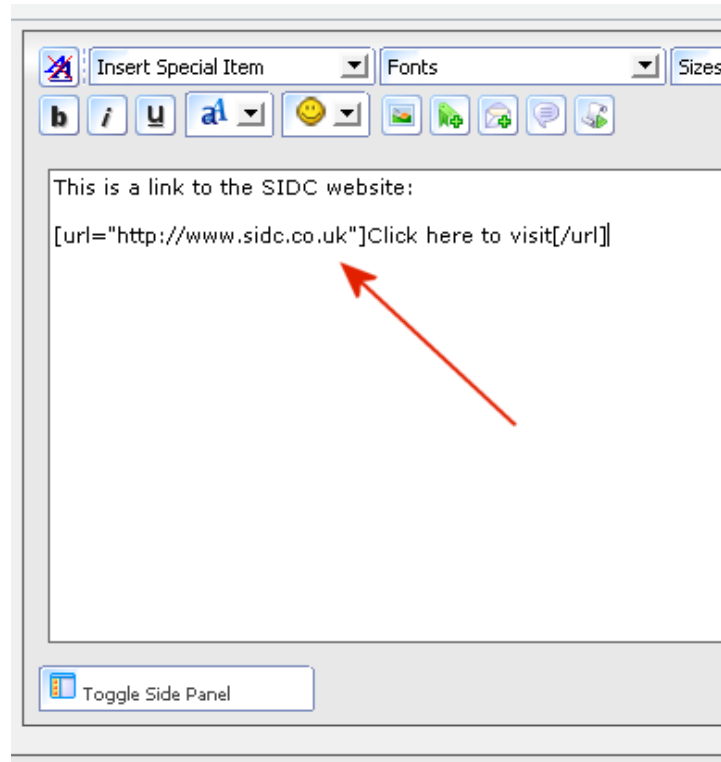


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Once you've done that and submitted it you will see some strange looking code inserted into your message:



Don't worry about that. It's just the Forum software inserting your link in the format it understands.
