**Eligibility:** All riders must hold a current ACU Registration card or SACU Licence. Other riders, must produce a licence and Start Permission confirming Insurance from their FMN.

**Entries.** To be received by the Secretary of the Meeting before 6th March 2010 together with an entry fee of **£20 plus 3 SAE.**

**Classes:** Expert, Intermediate and Clubman. ADULTS, only trial.

**Start.** The start will be at The Cricket Pavilion, Castleton, N/ Yorks. Moors. The first rider will start at **9.30 am** the rest as notified in the Final Instructions. The trial route **will** include use of public roads. One event RTA insurance cover will be available at the start.

The trial entry will be limited to 180. In the event of the trial being over-subscribed there will be a ballot shortly after the closing date. Entry fee is only refundable if the entry is rejected.

If you send more than one entry in an envelope please send one cheque per rider. Also, send separate SAE's for each Class of rider.

### **ACU. ROAD TRAFFIC ACT INSURANCE SCHEME.**

The Club has applied to Lockton for a Blanket Cover Note under the above scheme. This will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the Event.

The basic rate for the event will be £9 (Please send separate cheque payable to Lockton).

All new applicants wishing to use the scheme must be able to comply with all the points of the Lockton's Declaration:

- **Over 21 and held a full licence for at least 6 months**
- **Not more than 1 fault accident in last 3 years**
- **No more than maximum of 6 speeding points on licence**
- **No physical or mental disabilities**
- **No other material facts**

If you comply with all points above – **No letter of Acceptance will be required.**

If unable to comply with any of the above points you will be required to complete the Declaration Form which should be forwarded either to the Club or direct to Lockton prior to the event to allow sufficient time for Letter of Acceptance to be issued. **Faxed copies are acceptable.**
