

Macclesfield Trials Club Dead Easy Trial report 28/10/2012

The final Dead Easy Trial of the year run by Macclesfield Trails Club was held at Rough Hey Quarry. The weather conditions were somewhat different to the previous week's winter championship trial with glorious sunshine replaced by the more customary damp and drizzle. The Dead Easy format gave a great opportunity for some aspiring young riders to have a go and for some of the more experienced riders to give their older bikes an airing. Riders completed 4 laps of 10 sections - each with 2 routes. A range of sections were provided by the setting out team, which gave surprising grip despite the rain. A number of riders provided some additional entertainment in aid of the Blue Peter Appeal for Children in Need by riding for charity whilst wearing pajamas.

In the Twin Shock class an outstanding clean score sheet by Toby Eyre gave him the win. Wayne Mycock took 2nd place only dropping a single point with James Ford picking up 3rd place.

Wain Edwards, Tony Pratt and Paul Hunter had to share the honor of winning the harder route, all having excellent rides and clean score sheets. 4th place went to Dougie Greenall dropping just one mark and 5th place went to Mark Castle by most cleans.

On the easy route, youth rider Daniel Renshaw was the winner dropping just 5 marks throughout. Simon Clarke and Stephen Simpson dropped 6 marks each with Simon taking 2nd place by virtue of most cleans.
